What is a mail order pharmacy?

Mail order pharmacies provide a reliable, and affordable option for patients to safely access prescription drugs from the convenience of their own home.

Mail order pharmacies offer 24/7 access to customer service representatives and pharmacists, including translation services and special services for individuals with disabilities.

Mail order pharmacies typically provide 90-day prescriptions for drugs that are used to treat chronic conditions.

How does mail order help consumers?

By keeping costs down - mail order pharmacies have greater efficiency and lower overhead costs than retail pharmacies.

By saving money - home delivery will save consumers, employers, and health plans \$59.6 billion over 10 years.

By improving medication adherence - 84.7% of patients who received their medications by mail stuck to their prescribed regimen at least two-thirds of the time.


By ensuring accuracy - mail service pharmacies dispense prescriptions with 23-times greater accuracy than retail pharmacies.

Why do health plans use mail order pharmacies?

Health plans establish robust pharmacy networks to provide their members with access to highly trained pharmacists and clinicians providing cost-effective prescription medications through the mail where appropriate.

Mail order pharmacies employ pharmacists that focus on clinical and cost-management functions, rather than basic prescription processing, to save money and deliver high-quality care to members.

Health plans do not require members to use mail order pharmacies, but encouraged use during the COVID-19 pandemic to ensure safe, continuous access to medications.
